





COCKTAILS

Bowery Lane has a range of inspirations in creating our cocktail list. The golden age of cocktails (Jerry Thomas) 1880's - 1890's is interweaved with (Pre) Prohibition (1919-1933) & Cocktails that came from that Era form our framework. General Americana & New York inspirations through common knowledge and media along with our appreciation for coffee are then used leaning on the history of Bowery and its relation to the farm lands.

The historic 1.5 mile (2.4 km) Bowery is the oldest thoroughfare on Manhattan Island. It was a dirt trail etched by the bare feet and moccasins of the Native Americans. The Bowery's first residents were ten families of freed slaves in 1645. Then in the late 17th century when the Dutch settled Manhattan island, they named the path Bouwerij road. "Bouwerij" is an old Dutch word for "farm" and was appropriate as it connected farmlands and estates on the outskirts to the heart of the city in today's Wall Street and Battery Park area. By the end of the 18th century, the Bowery became New York's most elegant street, lined with grand theaters, soaring banks, mansions of prosperous residents and fashionable shops.

During the Civil War era, the mansions and shops had given way to low-brow concert halls, brothels, German beer gardens, pawn shops, and flophouses. The Bowery also marked the eastern border of the slum of "Five Points" - popularized in the movie Gangs of New York. The Bowery then became the turf of one of America's earliest street gangs, the native Bowery Boys. Additionally, at the end of the 19th century, many low quality tenements were built to accommodate the many immigrants pouring into the city. The construction in 1878 of the Third Avenue Elevated Train (deconstructed in 1955) over the Bowery added pollution, darkened the streets below and further precipitated the decline of the area. It is also a fact that the Bowery is the only major thoroughfare in New York never to have had a single church built upon it.



A Bowery Ln original inspired by "The Clover Club" that pre-dates Prohibition and is named for the Philadelphia men's club of the same name.


Our twist comes in the form of Blanco Tequila and offering a hint aromatics through Rose Syrup.

THE BOURBON CRUSTA


A shaken twist on a classic "The Brandy Crusta – Jerry Thomas (1862)", Jerry Thomas was one of the first inventors and innovators of cocktails as we know them now. When Mr. Thomas was first mixing cocktails there was a very specific definition for a cocktail – it was a blend of spirits, water, sugar and bitters. He broke all the rules by adding citrus and keeping the sugar external. We have taken the same specs for the classic, replaced the cognac/brandy with Buffalo Trace Bourbon.

A good balance between sour and dryness offered by a hint of Luxardo, Overall it will remind you of a lemon sherbet. This is the kind of cocktail you can use to taste if you are a non bourbon drinker!

KRAKEN NEGRONI

Another twist on a classic "The Negroni - Count Camillo Negroni (1919)".

This drink is said to have been invented by Count Camillo when he asked a bartender at Caffe Casoni (Florence, Italy) to strengthen his favorite cocktail, The Americano, by adding gin rather than the normal soda. We have played with the recipe to find the best balance between the sweetness of the Kraken Spiced Rum and the bitterness of the Campari.

A Perfect aperitif offering the balance of bitter to sweet to help open your appetite. The slow nature of this cocktail allows to build a viscous texture to highlight the sweetness of the Kraken, which in turn highlights the bitterness of the Campari.




A FRENCH 3 WAY


I'm sure your first thought of this cocktail was one of sultry seduction after a few too many drinks with some #upforit friends. Unfortunately, it's just a name!

SALTED MAPLE OLD FASHIONED


An Old fashioned follows the original definition of what cocktails were then - Blend of spirits (usually bourbon or rye), Water, Sugar & Bitters. The Old Fashioned is possibly now "the manliest cocktail" someone can order but probably something "your grandmother drank" or in some of your cases "your great grandmother".

As much as it is probably the oldest of old cocktails and the original will have a great place in every bartenders heart. The simplicity of this cocktail has given almost every bar a platform to make a statement, a surface on which every bartender leaves a thumbprint.

Our Old Fashioned – Contrary to what the name suggests we do not add any salt this cocktail. Instead, we use "Talisker 10" one of the saltiest whisky's out there and we work in reverse – to highlight the saltiness we offer the opposite.




